**Education:**

She attended elementary and secondary school in her hometown. After finishing secondary school, she worked on homespuns.

She graduated from the Faculty of Law of Janus Pannonius University of Pécs in 1981. As a trainee lawyer delegated by the chamber of lawyers of Szekszárd, she was sent to Tamási, Tolna County.

**Career:**

After passing the exams that qualified her as a lawyer, she was employed as a lawyer in Tamási.

As from 1991, she worked as a freelance lawyer.

She joined the Hungarian Democratic Forum (MDF) in January 1989.

In the 1990 elections, she was elected MP for Tamási. In Parliament, initially she was a member of the committee for elections and credentials.

As from 1991, she served on the rules committee.

From September 1992, she was elected chair of that committee. In 1994, she once again stood for Parliament in Tamási.

Eventually, she was returned to Parliament on her party's national list.

Between 1994 and 1998, she had the following functions in Parliament: membership in the constitutional and judicial committee, membership in the team of legal experts within the parliamentary group of MDF, deputy leader of her party's parliamentary group.

The national convention of her party elected her onto the party's national board in 1996.

In the 1998 elections, she was returned to Parliament once again representing Tamási.
