Dear President,

As you may know, the European Parliament and the Assemblies of the OSCE and of the Council of Europe agreed with the Special Coordinator of the Stability Pact for South Eastern Europe to sponsor the parliamentary dimension of the Stability Pact.

These three institutions agreed to be part of a Troika/Task Force on Parliamentary Cooperation, covering all sectors concerned by the Stability Pact, in particular its three Working Tables and its Sub-Tables.

The European Parliament, who holds the Presidency of the Troika/Task Force during the second half of 2001, announced at the recent Regional Table of the Stability Pact on 28 June that it will organise, within this context, *a Parliamentary Conference on 17 and 18 September in Brussels*. Parliamentarians from all the partner countries of the Stability Pact and from the candidate countries for accession to the European Union will be invited to this conference, as well as representatives of the organisations which are also partners of the Stability Pact.

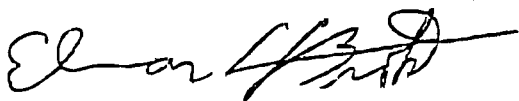
It is our pleasure to invite a delegation of two parliamentarians from your Parliament to participate in this conference which will examine the parliamentary contribution to stabilisation and regional cooperation, the new priorities for reconstruction and economic development and the fight against organised crime, in particular trafficking.
