Following its decision of 15 September 2004, the European Parliament has set up a Temporary Committee on Policy Challenges and Budgetary Means of the Enlarged Union 2007-2013. The temporary committee, which I have the honour of chairing, has the mandate to define the European Parliament's negotiating position in the debate on the next Financial Perspective.

In this context, the Committee has decided to hold an exchange of views with a maximum of four representatives from each of the national parliaments.

The hearing will take place on **4 and 5 April 2005** in the European Parliament premises in Brussels.

The meeting will be structured on the basis of three thematic sections reflecting the main topics of the next financial perspective, as indicated in the draft programme in annex.

It would be useful if you could indicate which representatives will attend the hearing.

I hope this meeting will contribute to improving the understanding by the representatives of the European citizens of the means to be allocated to the Union in future.
