KATALIN SZILI (Mrs.)
Speaker of the Parliament of the Hungarian Republic

Curriculum Vitae

She was born in Barcs on 13 May 1956. She is married and has two adopted children. Her husband is a civil engineer.

She finished Nagy Lajos Secondary School in Pécs in 1974. She received her JD from the Faculty of Law of Janus Pannonius University in 1981.

She worked as a desk officer for child custody issues in the administrative department of the municipal council in Pécs from 1982. She passed the bar and legal counsel examination in 1985 and became head of the legal department in the same year. She worked as a legal counsellor for the South-Transdanubia Water Authorities from 1985 until 1992, and later for the Environmental Protection Inspectorate. She studied human ecology at the Faculty of Sciences of Eötvös Loránd University of Budapest from 1990 until 1992. She became a full-time environmental expert of the parliamentary group of the Hungarian Socialist Party in 1993. She obtained her next degree in political studies in 2001.

She joined the Hungarian Socialist Workers' Party (MSZMP) in 1983. In November 1989, she became a member of the Hungarian Socialist Party (MSZP) and head of the municipal legal assistance service. She was president of the party's Baranya County organisation and head of the Women's Division of the party from 1997 until 2001. She was elected to deputy of the party's president at the November 2000 congress of the MSZP. She was re-elected as deputy to the party president as the only candidate on 29 March 2003. She was also elected to head of the group of experts in charge of modernising the structure of the party.

She ran as a candidate in the 1990 parliamentary elections in Pécs. She was elected to the Pécs Assembly in the by-elections held in May 1992. She has been an individual MP representing her Pécs constituency (Constituency 2, Baranya County) since 1994.

She was parliamentary secretary of the Ministry of Environment and Regional Development from 1994 until 1998. She was deputy speaker of Parliament and a member of the Committee on Standing Orders from June 1998 until May 2002. She was deputy leader of her party's parliamentary group from 2001 until 2002. She was elected incumbent MP for her Pécs constituency in the first round of the elections in 2002.

She was elected to speaker of Parliament on 15 May 2002.
