I wish to write to you directly to inform you that at the recent Presidential elections in the Republic of Cyprus, the Greek-Cypriot electorate bestowed on me the great honour of electing me President of the Republic of Cyprus.

It is with great pleasure that I address this letter to you in order to express my wholehearted appreciation for the cooperation we have had until very recently as fellow chairpersons of our respective Parliamentary Committees on European Affairs within the framework of COSAC and other related meetings.

Following the successful completion of accession negotiations between the ten applicant countries and the European Union and the Copenhagen European Council decision on these countries' accession, I need hardly emphasize the crucial role our Committees have played within our national Parliaments in the gigantic enlargement effort in particular and in the furtherance of European construction in general. Undoubtedly, national Parliaments still have a pivotal place in this on-going process and I trust that European Affairs Committees at "15" + "10" will carry on with their excellent work in the transitional period up to 1 May 2004 and thereafter, in an enhanced combination of duties and rights within a United Europe of "25".
