Parliamentary Assembly Session : 24 to 30 June 2006 ▲

Limit competence of the EU's Fundamental Rights Agency to application of Community law, says PACE President

[26/06/2006] "We have entered a decisive phase of negotiations with the European Union on our future relations", President of the Council of Europe Parliamentary Assembly, René van der Linden.

He stressed the need for agreement on the EU's Fundamental Rights Agency, whose competence should be limited to examination on the merits, to the application of European Community law and, in geographical terms, to the EU member states to avoid duplication and wasting European tax-payers' money.

He also called for recognition of the Council of Europe's role as the lead organisation for questions of democracy, human rights and the rule of law in Europe, and for strong emphasis on the parliamentary dimension in keeping with the wishes of European citizens, who wished to see European organisations become more democratic.
